3. Competitors if involved in more than one event will have a minimum break of 40 minutes between competitions.
4. All bowls must bear a stamp in accordance with the Laws of the Sport.
5. All competitors are advised to make themselves conversant with **Law 35 “Possession of the Rink”**.
6. A meal has been arranged for the Officials, Players and Guests after all the finals have been completed.
7. Snacks and refreshments will be available during the day.
8. Dress for all the finals will be – **White Trousers, White Shirts (with Club Tie) or Club Coloured Shirts (as approved), Blazer and White Shoes. Players should arrive dressed in their Blazer, White Shirt and Club Tie. Note: Where Club Coloured Shirts are worn all players in the team must wear them.**
9. At the National Finals **White, County or Club coloured shirts will be worn provided that all members of the side wear the same.**
